1. RELEASED PARTIES DEFINED

The "Released Parties," for the following event: Miss Rodeo Nevada 2020 Pageant, are Gaughan South LLC, Gaughan Straight Holdings Inc., Miss Rodeo Nevada Association, any sponsor company of the Event, and any of the above listed companies officers, directors, employees, shareholders, contractors, affiliates, agents and representatives, (individually and collectively referred to as "Released Parties"). This entire Agreement is referred to as the "South Point Participation Release."

2. EXPRESS ACKNOWLEDGMENT, ACCEPTANCE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

The undersigned participant is fully aware, completely understands, and accepts that participation in the Event, whether as a contestant, employee, volunteer, exhibitor, sponsor or spectator, is dangerous and that the events and activities associated with, relating to, arising out of, and concerning this participation present substantial, serious, and real risks of personal injury or death to the undersigned participant, and the loss of, damage to, or destruction of the undersigned participant's personal property. The undersigned participant, by his/her signature below, fully and completely accepts and assumes these substantial, serious, and real risks whether or not apparent, known, unknown, foreseen, unforeseen, present, or contingent, and whether or not caused by any negligence of the Released Parties, or the negligence of any contestant, volunteer or spectator including but not limited to, any negligence associated with the design or designing, staging, supervising, maintaining or in any way presenting, conducting or sponsoring the Event.

3. FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL WAIVER AND RELEASE

Regarding Section 1 and 2 above, which are incorporated into this Section 3, the undersigned participant expressly and completely waives, releases, discharges, holds harmless and otherwise agrees not to sue any of the Released Parties in any manner for any claim, loss or damage, or through any forum, at common law or under any statute, rule, regulation, order or law.

4. ASSURANCES

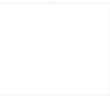

Miss Rodeo Nevada Association Fundraising and Reimbursement Guidelines

All monies raised, donated, directed or given to Miss Rodeo Nevada or The Miss Rodeo Nevada Association will be given to the Director of Finance for proper record keeping per the guidelines stated below.

MRNA will provide the following to MRN

- Stationery and business cards
- Autograph sheets - begin with 500
- Pro Rodeo Sports News subscription - for year of reign
- Use of perpetual prizes including but not limited to - crown, chaps, arena shirts, sashes. These will be returned no later than the last day of the 2021 MRNA pageant.

Sponsorship Packages

1. MRN will be given all necessary material and information to prepare sponsorship packages. With assistance from the Association, MRN will establish her own target market to solicit sponsorship dollars.
2. Money raised from personal sponsorship packages by MRN will be divided between the Association (20%) and MRN (80%).
3. The Association will solicit like sponsorships and retain 100% of the proceeds. These sponsorships are used to fund various things for MRN i.e. tear sheets, business cards, travel expenses, etc. as well as MRNA pageant and business expenses.

Fundraising

The Association may have fundraisers and assist MRN with personal fundraising efforts. Details will be determined by the Association. MRN will be required to be in attendance and participate in the fundraiser. The Association will retain 100% of all monies raised at this event.

MRN will be required to host a Fundraiser at her expense. This Fundraiser will be considered MRN's major fundraising event that will help fund her travels and expenses throughout her reign in addition to her sponsorship packages. MRN and/or her family must be in close communication with the MRA National Director - Nevada as to her plans for the Fundraiser. The Association will be available to assist and guide to make this effort a success. 80% of all monies raised will go to MRN and 20% will go to the Association.

Additional Fundraising Events

It is recommended that MRN actively participate in raising funds during her reign to support her travel endeavors and preparations for MRA. This can include, but is not limited to BBQ, door prizes, auction, raffles, gas cards, dress and/or jewelry donations. MRN is **NOT** limited to one activity. All fundraising events **MUST** be approved by the Association. Money raised from these events will be divided 80% to MRN and 20% to the Association.

Initial

Reimbursement Policy

The National Director must issue approval in writing for any and all expenses by MRNA, prior to the event/trip. A copy of all requests for reimbursement MUST be sent to the National Director no later than 60 days from expense occurrence. MRN will be reimbursed for approved expenses made after her selection as MRN through the selection of MRN 2021 on a monthly basis by the Director of Finance. MRN/MRNA must have funds available in order to receive reimbursement.

Reimbursable Items (for Queen only) example: if Queen and family/friends eat out, Queen part must be on separate bill to be submitted.

Some reimbursement will be drawn from the Association’s account; these items may include, but are not limited to:

- Required Travel expenses including transportation, housing and food
- MRA Pageant entry fee
- up to \$500 towards chaps, If ordered by deadline of May 1st of reigning year, no compensation if chaps are donated
- Any coaching required by MRNA
- Half of cost towards MRA pageant program ad; up to \$500.00.

Optional travel is defined as travel that is not required by MRNA and is not paid for by the Association. Any optional travel must be pre-approved by the National Director and paid for by MRN.

Each expense greater than \$200 must be pre-approved by the National Director in order to be considered for reimbursement.

Travel Expense Limits For Queen only

- Hotel up to \$200/ night - MRN is encouraged to stay with host families if possible
- Food – up to \$80/day
- Air Travel - reservations must be made at least 14 days prior to travel date unless approved by the Association.

It is the intent of the Association to reimburse MRN for all approved required reimbursable expenditures during her reign as long as funding is available to do so. It is NOT the intent of the Association for MRN or her family to profit financially from her reign as Miss Rodeo Nevada. Any funds left unspent at the end of MRN’s reign will become the property of MRNA.
